



Announcement of the Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music
ADMISSION OF STUDENTS TO THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026 (QUOTA ROUND)

The Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music (PGVIM) invites applications for admission to the Bachelor of Music Program, School of Music, for the Academic Year 2026 (Quota Round). The application and selection period runs from **29 January - 13 March 2026**.

1. Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet all of the following conditions:

- 1.1. Graduated from or expecting to graduate from Mathayom 6 (or equivalent).
- 1.2. A cumulative GPA (GPAX) of at least 2.00 over four semesters.
- 1.3. Demonstrated musical ability including proficiency on the primary instrument, theoretical understanding of Western music and music history, and aural skills suitable for undergraduate study, as specified by the Institute.
- 1.4. Commitment to music study, awareness of contemporary global developments, and understanding of the role of music in Thai, ASEAN, and international contexts, in line with PGVIM's philosophy.
- 1.5. Proficiency on a secondary instrument (e.g. Thai, ASEAN, or electronic instruments) will be given additional consideration.
- 1.6. Applicants with a U.S. GED must have achieved at least 145 points per subject and a total score of no less than 640 points.
- 1.7. No health condition or illness that may interfere with academic performance or professional practice.
- 1.8. Compliance with all other eligibility requirements as specified by the Institute.

Note: Students residing outside Thailand may also apply.

2. Required Documents

Applicants must upload the following to the PGVIM Admission system

(<http://www.pgvim.ac.th/admission/>):.

2.1. Portfolio

Must follow the Institute's prescribed format and include a QR code linking to unedited YouTube videos, as follows:

2.1.1. Perform repertoire as listed on the PGVIM Admission website.

2.1.2. Videos must clearly show the performer's face and technique, recorded continuously without any audio or video editing.

2.1.3. Portfolios will not be returned under any circumstances.

2.2. Statement of Purpose

Minimum one A4 page in length, clearly expressing the applicant's motivation, goals, and understanding of the program. It should include:

2.2.1. **Learning and career goals (short- and long-term):** clear, reasoned, and aligned with future professional development.

2.2.2. **Program alignment:** understanding of PGVIM's curriculum, learning philosophy, and environment, and how these support the applicant's goals.

2.2.3. **Self-awareness and development plan:** reflection on strengths, areas for improvement, and a plan for personal growth.

2.2.4. **Writing quality:** structured, concise, accurate, and effectively communicates ideas.

2.3. Official transcripts for four semesters.

2.4. Any additional documentation as specified on the PGVIM Admission website.

3. Evaluation and Scoring

The Admissions Committee will assign up to 100 points as follows:

3.1. GPAX (4 semesters): 10 points

3.2. Portfolio: 10 points

3.3. Statement of Purpose: 20 points

3.4. Practical Examination: 30 points

3.5. Interview: 30 points

4. Application Submission and Notification

4.1. Applicants must verify their eligibility and review all admission requirements for the Bachelor of Music program on the PGVIM Admission website. Any candidate found to be ineligible at any point, even after passing the entrance examinations, will be disqualified without refund.

4.2. Eligible applicants must complete the online application via the PGVIM Admission website, providing accurate information and uploading all required documents.

Incomplete or incorrect submissions may be corrected by the applicant within the official application period; failure to do so before the deadline will render the application invalid.

- 4.3. Applicants must pay a non-refundable application fee of THB 2,000 by bank transfer to Krung Thai Bank, Arunnamarin Intersection Branch, Account No. 157-0-26285-3 (Account Name: Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music). Proof of payment must be uploaded to the PGVIM Admission system.
- 4.4. The list of candidates eligible for interview and audition will be announced on **20 March 2026** via the PGVIM Admission website.

5. Interview and Audition

The Institute will conduct interviews and instrument auditions on **27 March 2026** as follows:

5.1. Interview

The interview assesses study attitude, life perspective, problem-solving ability, English communication, general music knowledge (including theory and history), and any additional skills related to music technology or other relevant abilities.

5.2. Practical Examination (Primary Instrument)

Applicants must perform technical exercises and repertoire on their primary instrument as specified by the Institute.

6. Agreement Acknowledgment and Clearing-house Confirmation

- 6.1. The list of successful candidates invited to confirm admission through the Clearing-house system will be announced on **3 April 2026** via the PGVIM Admission website.
- 6.2. Selected candidates must appear in person at the Institute on **6 April 2026** to acknowledge terms and confirm intent to study.
- 6.3. Candidates must confirm their place through the TCAS Clearing-house system (<https://student.mycas.com/>) during 2–3 May 2026.
Failure to confirm by the deadline will result in forfeiture of admission. Only one update to the confirmation is permitted.

7. Final Admission and Registration

- 7.1. The list of admitted students will be published on **9 May 2026** on the PGVIM Admission website.
- 7.2. Admitted students must complete registration by **16 May 2026**.
- 7.3. Registration fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.

8. Scholarships

Admitted students wishing to apply for financial aid must submit the required scholarship application form and supporting documents on the day of registration.

9. Orientation

Orientation will be held in mid-July 2026. Details and contact channels with the Institute will be provided on the registration day.
