

JOB ANNOUNCEMENT VISITING LECTURER

Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music (PGVIM) seeks qualified and enthusiastic Visiting Lecturers to join its School of Music. This is an eight-month contract reporting to the Dean of the School of Music, with a start date to be agreed, and is open to international applicants only.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Engage in collaborative artistic research by using PGVIM's facilities and resources to develop projects, explore new ideas, and enrich the Institute's creative environment.
- 2. Teach, coordinate, manage, and continuously refine Bachelor of Music courses across diverse musical disciplines.
- 3. Mentor and advise students in individual, group, and classroom settings, fostering their artistic growth and project development.
- 4. Collaborate with faculty and community partners to stimulate artistic exchange and interdisciplinary dialogue.
- 5. Present or publish at least one scholarly article, creative work, or academic document during the contract period.
- 6. Oversee and report on any projects assigned by the School of Music or Institute leadership.
- 7. Perform other duties and responsibilities as assigned to support PGVIM's mission.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Minimum three years of higher-education teaching experience.
- 2. Passion for teaching, mentorship, and student development.
- 3. Excellent interpersonal, communication, and collaboration skills
- 4. Growth mindset, strong work ethic, and commitment to ethical standards in teaching and research.
- 5. Ability to generate and implement ideas aligned with PGVIM's vision and mission.

SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS

1. Hold a doctoral degree in music, fine arts, or a related field by the contract start date; candidates from related fields must demonstrate equivalent music expertise through a thesis, publications, or presentations.

- 2. Possess a minimum of three years' professional artistic-research experience.
- 3. Show a documented record of international-level professional activity

Candidates demonstrating experience in music performance integrating technology or in music technology; in overseeing music practicum areas; in artistic research; and/or in managing and executing music-related projects or events will be considered a strong asset.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Submit the application form either in person or by email at hr@pgvim.ac.th and by 31 July 2025.
- 2. A list of candidates selected for presentations and interviews will be announced within one week of the application deadline.

PRESENTATION AND INTERVIEW

- 1. Conduct a 15-minute mock teaching session on a topic of your choice for the committee.
- 2. Deliver a 15-minute presentation on a topic related to your past or current research or area of expertise, highlighting its impact.
- 3. Present a 15-minute research proposal, emphasizing its relevance and potential impact in alignment with PGVIM's mission.
- 4. Participate in a 15-minute interview with the committee.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

- 1. The total compensation, including salary and experience, shall not exceed 50,000 THB and may be subject to adjustment based on relevant experience.
- 2. Group insurance benefits will be provided to the successful candidate by PGVIM.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Completed application form provided by PGVIM.
- 2. One 3x4 cm photograph taken within the last six months, showing the applicant with a neutral expression, facing straight at the camera.
- 3. Copy of degree certification(s) or equivalent document(s).
- 4. Copy of higher education transcripts.
- 5. Copy of passport and/or national identification card.
- 6. One-page cover letter describing your interest in the position, relevant experience, and qualifications.
- 7. Statement of teaching philosophy.
- 8. Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- 9. Three letters of reference.
- 10. Web link to at least one video recording of a recent live performance or artistic research presentation.
- 11. Copies of journal articles or creative works (if available).
- 12. English proficiency test results (except for native English speakers or applicants who have earned their doctoral degree in an English-speaking country).

13. Application fee of 100 THB per application.

Note: The successful candidate will be required to submit a medical certificate.
