

JOB ANNOUNCEMENT FULL-TIME LECTURER UNDER THE SCHOOL OF MUSIC

Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music (PGVIM) is seeking to appoint a Full-Time Lecturer (Creation & Technology Specialist) under the School of Music. The position reports to the Dean of the School of Music, with a starting date by 5 January 2026 or at the earliest convenience agreed upon by both parties. This application is open to any nationality.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Teach, organize, manage, and coordinate courses related to technology and creation modules in collaboration with the Bachelor of Music program, in compliance with curriculum standards and regulations both internally and externally.
- 2. Develop, plan, and oversee educational assessments within the assigned modules.
- 3. Manage and coordinate cross-disciplinary projects integrating music, technology, and creative production.
- 4. Support the development of short courses, workshops, or creative laboratories that enhance student skills in creation and innovation.
- 5. Teach and advise students in areas such as composition, audio and/or visual design, and related creative practices.
- 6. Conduct and present or publish research, compositions, or technology-related creative works at least once a year.
- 7. Participate in School or Institute-wide development projects as assigned.
- 8. Teach or coordinate other courses as assigned by the School of Music.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

The candidate should:

- 1. Provide evidence of at least three years of teaching experience at the higher education level.
- 2. Possess a strong passion for teaching and student development.
- 3. Be capable of guiding student projects and delivering effective instruction in individual, group, and classroom settings.
- 4. Be willing and able to work collaboratively across different fields of study.

- 5. Demonstrate a growth mindset and a commitment to achieving goals to fulfill job responsibilities effectively.
- 6. Exhibit a strong work ethic, clear communication skills, and empathy for effective collaboration with colleagues.
- 7. Maintain high ethical standards in teaching, research, and other related work.
- 8. Have experience managing and executing music-related projects and activities.
- 9. Demonstrate the ability to generate and implement ideas and projects aligned with PGVIM's vision and mission.

SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. The candidate must hold at least a Master's degree in Music, Music Technology, Composition, Sound Design, or related fields.
- 2. The candidate's creative work portfolio should include compositions, technology-related works or creations (such as sound design, visual media integration, or performance technology), and may include music performance if applicable.
- 3. Evidence of engagement in interdisciplinary or innovative artistic practice is desirable.

- 2. The list of shortlisted applicants invited for presentation and interview will be announced on 11 November 2025.

- 4. The results will be announced within five (5) days following the presentation and interview.

PRESENTATION AND INTERVIEW

- 1. Conduct a 15-minute mock teaching session on a topic of your choice for the committee.
- 2. Deliver a 10-minute presentation on a topic related to your past or current research or area of expertise, explaining its impact.
- 3. Present a 10-minute research proposal aligned with PGVIM's missions.
- 4. Participate in a 15-minute interview with the committee.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

- 1. The base salary offered is 23,800 THB, which can be adjusted depending on relevant experience.
- 2. The selected candidate will receive all benefits offered by PGVIM.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Completed application form provided by PGVIM.
- 2. One (1) 3x4 cm photograph taken within the last six months, showing the applicant looking straight at the camera with a neutral expression.
- 3. Copy of degree certificate(s) or equivalent document(s).
- 4. Copy of higher education transcripts.
- 5. Copy of passport and/or national identification card.
- 6. One-page cover letter describing interest in the position, relevant experience, and qualifications.
- 7. Statement of teaching philosophy.
- 8. Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- 9. Three (3) letters of reference.
- 10. Web link to at least one video recording of a recent live performance or creative work.
- 11. Copies of journal articles, compositions, or creative works (if any).
- 12. English proficiency test results, except for native English speakers or applicants who have earned their degree in an English-speaking country.
- 13. Application fee of 100 Baht per application.
- 14. For the successful candidate only:
 - a. Medical certificate showing physical fitness for work.
 - b. Certificate of psychological and physical fitness for work
