JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

FULL-TIME LECTURER UNDER THE SCHOOL OF MUSIC

Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music (PGVIM) is seeking to appoint a Full-Time Lecturer under the School of Music. The position reports to the Dean of the School of Music, with a starting date no later than 1 July 2026. This position is **open to both Thai and international applicants**.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Teach, organize, manage, and coordinate courses related to **musicianship, including music theory and aural skills, with keyboard skills considered an asset**, in collaboration with the Bachelor of Music program. The teaching should **integrate musicianship with performance, music history, composition, and creative practice**, in compliance with internal and external curriculum standards and regulations.
2. Develop, plan, and oversee integrated educational assessments within the assigned area, ensuring alignment between musicianship, performance, music history, composition, and creative practice.
3. Co-coordinate and/or co-advise students in creation and music technology modules as assigned. Specialized experience or a professional portfolio in technology and creation will be considered an advantage, but **will not be the main criterion for selection**.
4. Support the development of short courses, workshops, or creative laboratories that enhance student musicianship, creativity, and innovation.
5. Teach and advise students in areas related to musicianship and the candidate's area of expertise.
6. Conduct and present or publish research, creative works, or academic works at least once a year.
7. Participate in School or Institute-wide development projects as assigned.
8. Teach or coordinate other courses as assigned by the School of Music.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

The candidate should demonstrate qualities aligned with PGVIM's institutional values:

1. Provide evidence of at least three years of teaching experience at the higher education level.
2. Passion - Demonstrate a strong passion for teaching, student development, music, and the sharing of knowledge with others.
3. Growth - Show a commitment to continuous development in both professional knowledge and personal maturity, with a growth mindset toward learning, feedback, and improvement.

4. Visionary Thinking - Be able to think forward, understand future trends in music education and professional practice, and contribute to sustainable development aligned with PGVIM's vision and mission.
5. Integration - Be willing and able to work collaboratively across disciplines, cultures, and diverse learning contexts, with clear communication, empathy, accountability, and constructive engagement with others.
6. Mastery - Demonstrate professional expertise in music and related fields, with the ability to apply such expertise effectively in teaching, advising, research, creative work, academic activities, institutional service, and music-related projects.
7. Maintain high ethical standards in teaching, research, creative work, and other professional responsibilities.

SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS

1. The candidate must hold a Master's or Doctoral degree in Music or a related field.
2. The candidate should demonstrate expertise in musicianship, including music theory, aural skills, keyboard skills, or related areas.
3. A professional portfolio in technology, creation, composition, audio/visual design, or related creative practice will be considered an advantage.
4. Evidence of engagement in interdisciplinary or innovative artistic practice is desirable.

3. Presentations and interviews will be conducted on 16 June 2026 from 3 pm onwards.

PRESENTATION AND INTERVIEW

1. Conduct a 15-minute mock teaching session on a topic related to musicianship, with an explanation of how musicianship, including music theory, aural skills, and listening skills, relates to performance and music history.

2. Deliver a 10-minute presentation on a topic related to your past or current research, creative work, or area of expertise, explaining its impact.
3. Present a 10-minute research or creative proposal aligned with PGVIM's missions.
4. Participate in a 15-minute interview with the committee.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

1. The base salary offered is 23,800 THB for a Master's degree and 28,600 THB for a Doctoral degree, which may be adjusted depending on relevant experience.
2. The selected candidate will receive all benefits offered by PGVIM.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Completed application form provided by PGVIM.
2. One (1) 3x4 cm photograph taken within the last six months, showing the applicant looking straight at the camera with a neutral expression.
3. Copy of degree certificate(s) or equivalent document(s).
4. Copy of higher education transcripts.
5. Copy of passport and/or national identification card.
6. One-page cover letter describing interest in the position, relevant experience, and qualifications.
7. Statement of teaching philosophy.
8. Curriculum Vitae (CV).
9. Three (3) letters of reference.
10. Web link to at least one video recording of a recent live performance or creative work.
11. Copies of journal articles, compositions, or creative works (if any).
12. English proficiency test results, except for native English speakers or applicants who have earned their degree in an English-speaking country.
13. Copy of application fee payment slip (100 Baht).
14. For the successful candidate only:
 - a. Medical certificate showing physical fitness for work.
 - b. Certificate of psychological and physical fitness for work
